1.0 Legal Base

The reasonable accommodation arises from the Federal Law American with Disabilities Act of 1990 (Law ADA). This law protects the rights of people with disabilities, its purpose is eliminate discrimination towards people with disabilities and ensure equality opportunities.

2.0 Definitions

Reasonable Accommodation - A reasonable accommodation is a modification or adjustment to the educational scenario that allows the student with disabilities participate and perform in their academic functions in equal conditions that the other students who do not have impediment

2.0 Policy
