1.0 Legal Base

The reasonable accommodation arises from the Federal Law American with Disabilities Act of 1990 (Law ADA). This law protects the rights of people with disabilities, its purpose is to eliminate discrimination towards people with disabilities and ensure equality opportunities.

2.0 Definitions

Reasonable Accommodation - A reasonable accommodation is a modification or adjustment to the educational scenario that allows the student with disabilities participates and performs in their academic functions in equal conditions that the other students who do not have impediment.

2.0 Policy

Humacao Community College provides and guarantee reasonable accommodation services requested by students with impediments. The students request this service in the Counseling Office of the Institution.
